Maintenance and Care Guide

Fold and Roll Back Bar

- Do not use the bar outside in extreme weather, in an uncovered area. When not in use, do not leave the bar outside in a harsh environment. Weather damage is not covered by the warranty.
- When storing the bar: break it down, clean it and put on the cover. Store completely protected from the elements in a dry place. If you are by the ocean or in a humid climate, we recommend storing the bar indoors when not in use.
- Laminated panels should be dried if they become wet. Laminated panels should also be covered/protected from direct sunlight.
- Two persons are needed when transporting the bar. Be mindful of the acrylic panels and remove them from the frame of the bar if needed.
- While this bar is meant to be transported while stocked, avoid adding too much weight/overstocking when moving the bar long distances.
- Check powder coating regularly for any scratches or dings which may compromise the bar's weather resistance. If you find a scratch or ding, touch up paint should be used to cover the exposed steel immediately.
- Do not overtighten thumbscrews and hardware. This may lead to chipping of powder coat.
- Keep two hands on the bar when pushing them to help with its stability going over uneven surfaces.
- When transporting or breaking down the bar, be mindful of the LED strips and disconnect the appropriate cables and connectors (if applicable).
- When running your LED system, make sure that the battery is not being used while the charger is plugged into an outlet. Use only one power source at a time (if applicable).
- Do not leave your battery charged for more than 12 hours at a time (if applicable).
